

## What is FoKAB?

**King Alfred Motor Services (KAMS) ended on 28 April 1973. Friends of King Alfred Buses (FoKAB) was set up in 1985 after an appeal by James Freeman, who had bought and restored two former King Alfred buses. In 2000 FoKAB became a registered charity, and then later a charitable company limited by guarantee.**

**KAMS** operated bus services in Winchester from 1920 to 1973. One of the few privately owned bus companies to run a municipal service, its fleet of 30-40 vehicles at any one time always included the latest types. **KAMS** was just as professional as the "big" bus companies that surrounded it but was proudly independent, with the statue of King Alfred on the side panels of its green and cream buses.

**FoKAB** was formed over 40 years ago and is a thriving group with a membership of more than 200. With a fleet of 15 ex-**KAMS** vehicles 'on the road', and another under restoration, our continuing intention is to preserve *King Alfred* buses and coaches and the memory of **KAMS**. Our aim is that the local people of Winchester and Central Hampshire do not forget this special part of their recent heritage, in particular by running the buses on the old **KAMS** routes, recreating the 1960s bus scene in Winchester. This also provides historic buses for enthusiasts from all over the country to ride on and enjoy.



FoKAB originated the 'running day' (as opposed to a rally) where buses run on original routes. This developed into one of the major events in the bus calendar, formerly on New Year's Day, but now moved to May, although a few buses are still run on 1 January. Buses are also run as part of the Heritage Open Days in September.

## Membership Information

We have monthly evening meetings in Winchester, with guest speakers on transport related subjects. There are also outings using our vehicles, and members are welcome to ride on the buses and coaches when we take them to running days, rallies, and other events.

We rely on practical help from our members to keep the buses in service. Behind the scenes there is work ranging from vehicle maintenance and running repairs to major restoration, as well as premises maintenance, and many other tasks. Up front, we need conductors (who we can train) and drivers with a PCV (subject to type testing and insurance requirements).

The *Broadway Bulletin* magazine is published regularly, informing members of meetings, engineering reports, bus-related articles, and details of events to which we are taking a bus.
